



PUBLIC NOTICE OF PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD
Draft Preliminary Environmental Assessment/Removal Action Workplan
Lomita Park Elementary School, San Bruno California
Public Comment Period: May 9 to June 7, 2011

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) proposes a Draft Preliminary Environmental Assessment/Removal Action Workplan (Draft PEA/RAW). Lomita Park Elementary School, 200 Santa Helena Ave, is located at the southeastern corner of the intersection of Santa Helena Avenue and San Anselmo Avenue in San Bruno. If approved, the Draft PEA/RAW will allow the Millbrae Elementary School District to:

- Dig up pesticide contaminated soil around the perimeter of the school;
- Dispose the pesticide contaminated soil at an authorized off-site landfill;
- Use the school building's foundation and/or asphalt pavement to cap additional pesticide contaminated soil.
