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The Millbrae School District will offer, contingent upon funding, a **Language Arts and Math Academy** (formerly a Proficiency Summer School program) in the "H" Hall at Taylor Middle School to students currently in the 3rd through 7th grades. The program welcomes enrolled students on June 16, closes for a holiday on July 5th, and concludes on July 14th. The math and language arts curriculum will be offered to all students who are eligible and would benefit from the program. Teachers and Principals have completed the referral process.
