



Code of Conduct Student Edition



- 1. Drugs, Alcohol & Weapons:** None of these may be brought onto Taylor campus under any circumstances, nor should a student ever be in possession, discuss, or make plans to buy or sell any of these items.
- 2. No Touch Policy:** Students should use elbow bumps, fist bumps, or foot taps when greeting one another.
- 3. Entering the Buildings Before School:** Students may enter the school buildings at the first bell (8:13 am) each morning. Students may enter before the bell if they have an appointment with a teacher or administrator.
- 4. Cell Phones:** Cell phones and all other electronic devices must be turned off and placed in your backpack between the first bell (8:13 am) and the end of the school day (2:00 pm on Wednesdays; 3:00 on all other days). Students may use their device with teacher consent and presence with academic purposes.
- 5. Food and Snack:** Food and snacks are only to be eaten in areas with tables and at the amphitheater. Students shall dispose of their trash in the designated trash bins.
- 6. Dress Code:** Students are expected to "Dress for Success". Appropriate dress necessary to reduce distraction, promote health, and provide a productive learning environment. Stomachs, bras, and other private parts shall be covered.
- 7. Lockers:** Lockers are to be used by the student it is assigned to and combinations kept private. All food and drink shall be removed from lockers daily.
- 8. Bikes, Scooters, and Skateboards:** Bikes and scooters should be walked on campus to the bike rack, and locked up at the start of the school day. Bikes and scooters shall remain locked until dismissal when they may be picked up and walked off campus each day. Skateboards should be stored in your locker and may not be ridden on campus. Helmets need to be worn at all times while using bikes, scooters, and skateboards.
- 9. Hoods & Hats:** Students should not wear hoods or hats in hallways or classrooms. Hats shall be removed and placed on the desk until the end of each period.
- 10. Boundary Lines:** Students are to stay within the red lines during recess and lunch.
