DUE NO LATER THAN JUNE 30, 2021

For new applicant - to qualify for exemption from the Millbrae Elementary School District \$97.00 parcel tax during any tax year (July 1 – June 30), you must be receiving Supplemental Security Income (SSI) for a disability or Social Security Insurance benefits, you are the owner of a parcel within the Millbrae Elementary School District, and that parcel is your principal residence. You must own and live in your home as of July 1 of the year the tax is due. Along with this application form, you must include copies of the following documents:

- Benefits Verification Letter issued by the Social Security Administration receiving Supplemental Income for disability. This letter is obtained by going online at https://www.ssa.gov/ by calling the Social Security Administration Office at 1-800-772-1213 or by visiting a local Social Security Administration Office.
- One proof of residence (copy of driver's license or any copy of utility bill- PG&E/Phone/Water/Cable/Trash Bill)
- One proof of ownership (copy of property tax bill or tax bill w/homeowner's exemption) http://www.sanmateocountytaxcollector.org/SMCWPS/pages/secureSearch.jsp

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APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS FOR PARCEL TAX MEASURE N EXEMPTION OWNER RECEIVING SUPPLEMENTAL SECURITY INCOME FOR A DISABILITY or SOCIAL SECURITY DISABILITY INSURANCE BENEFITS for FISCAL YEAR 2020-2021

- 1) If you meet any of the following criteria, you may apply for an exemption from the Measure N parcel tax on a parcel of real property you own by submitting this application with the requested documentation:
 - For information regarding the annual Secured Property Tax bills, please check with the County of San Mateo County Tax Office website at:http://www.sanmateocountytaxcollector.org/SMCWPS/pages/secureSearch.jsp
 - You receive Supplemental Security Income for a disability, regardless of age, and you occupy the parcel as your principal residence ("SSI Exemption"); or
 - You receive Social Security Disability Insurance benefits, regardless of age, your yearly income does not exceed 250 percent of the 2012 federal poverty guidelines issued by the United States Department of Health and Human Services, and you occupy the parcel as your principal residence ("SSDI Exemption").
- 2) The District must receive the Exemption Application by June 30, 2020 in order for you to qualify for the exemption for the following year.
- 3) YOU ONLY NEED TO APPLY ONE TIME FOR THE MEASURE 'N' EXEMPTION. Once your application is approved, you will receive the exemption for the entire term of the parcel tax so long as you remain eligible. However, if you are granted an exemption, from time-to-time, the District may ask you to verify your eligibility.
