Ensuring a Safe and Welcoming Learning Environment for All



- Key Principles
 - **Student Rights:** All children have the right to a free and appropriate public education, regardless of their immigration or citizenship status.
 - **School Role:** Our schools will not voluntarily grant access to immigration enforcement officers without a valid judicial warrant or court order.
 - **Student Privacy:** We are legally obligated to protect student privacy. School districts are prohibited from collecting information (including social security numbers) about students' or their families' immigration status.
- MESD has met with site administration & admin assistants to review District protocols & procedures, information has been shared with all staff
- This evening, we are proposing BP/AR 5145.13, Response to Immigration Enforcement
- Monitoring absences and supporting families with resources
